Extract from Victorian Heritage Register, H2034:

“ The Auburn Uniting Church Complex is historically significant as the major nineteenth century Wesleyan complex in Victoria. It is unusual as an example of a complete, intact and little altered set of church buildings built simultaneously to one design. The Auburn Uniting Church Complex is architecturally significant as the finest example of Lombardic Romanesque church design in Australia. The church building is architecturally significant as the major work by the young and brilliant architect Alfred Dunn. ”
