“Human Trafficking”
Speaker: Dr Mark Zirnsak

Mark is the Director, Justice and International Mission, Synod of Victoria and Tasmania, Uniting Church in Australia.

He was employed as the Synod Social Justice Development Officer in the Uniting Church in Victoria and Tasmania in June 1999 and became Director of the Justice and International Mission Unit of the Uniting Church in Victoria and Tasmania in early 2004.

Mark is a member of the Victorian Responsible Gambling Ministerial Advisory Council, the Victorian Alcohol Policy Coalition and Chair of the Victorian Inter-Church Gambling Taskforce.

Mark is a member of the Secretariat for the Tax Justice Network in Australia. He is also active in anti-corruption movements, including Publish What You Pay Australia and Transparency International Australia. He has a PhD in Chemical Engineering from the University of Melbourne.

Margaret Docking is an Australian Midwife who cannot see mothers die in pregnancy when simple solutions could save them. Auburn Uniting Church assisted her with this vision by raising \$7,000 in 2013 to make short films about the need and the solutions. Those films have shifted the way people think about family size in Uganda.

Wise Choices for Life runs training workshops in Uganda in Reproductive health and family planning. We are a Christian community development organisation with a vision to reduce maternal deaths, orphans and poverty.

Wise Choices for Life is now going from strength to strength and the all Ugandan Team of trainers led by Joyce Kidulu and her Board of Directors are going weekly into prisons, schools and community outreaches.
