Auburn Uniting Church assisted her with this vision by raising \$7,000 in 2013 to make short films about the need and the solutions. Those films have shifted the way people think about family size in Uganda.

Wise Choices for Life runs training workshops in Uganda in Reproductive health and family planning. We are a Christian community development organisation with a vision to reduce maternal deaths, orphans and poverty.

Wise Choices for Life is now going from strength to strength and the all Ugandan Team of trainers led by Joyce Kidulu and her Board of Directors are going weekly into prisons, schools and community outreaches.
