### “Relics of a Former Time” Speaker: Rev. John Baldock

Father Baldock is the newly appointed vicar of St John's Camberwell after 12 years at St John's and St Agnes' Anglican Parish East Malvern. He is an active member of General Synod, The Diocesan Synod, the Diocesan Council and the Diocese's Finance Committee.

At St John's East Malvern, Father Baldock was also Chaplain of the Caulfield Campus of Monash University. He has also spent 20 years in senior management positions within national and international non-government organisations, both religious and secular. For instance in 1996-1999 he was the Associate Secretary-General, Religions for Peace (WCRP) in New York, having established a similar organisation in Australia, between 1989-1996.
