The first solo recital on the Church's Kawai piano will be given by internationally acclaimed pianist and organist Lachlan Redd. The programme will include works from classical to contemporary.

Lachlan has recorded two discs of Geoffrey Tozer compositions, *Pieces from Childhood* and *Pieces After Childhood* (2018). He has continued to perform on tour in eastern Australia, with performances of Mozart's Piano Concerto No. 27 in the Elisabeth Murdoch Hall, the world première of Tozer's Sonata in C at the Peninsula Music Festival, and a special performance at the Melbourne International Film Festival's première of *The Eulogy*. He also appears in the film and plays for the soundtrack.
